Review Safety-Wise pages 95–96 before beginning this badge. There must be one adult, currently certified as an instructor by the National Archery Association, or has equivalent certification or documented experience indicating knowledge and skill in teaching/supervising archery.

Complete 6 requirements.

1. Show that you understand the safety zones at an archery range.
2. Know and follow the archery range whistle commands.
3. Demonstrate the proper way to nock an arrow and draw back the string.
4. Demonstrate the correct stance used for shooting.
5. Be able to shoot a round at a target at a distance of 20 feet.
6. Demonstrate the correct way of pulling an arrow from the target, and picking it up from the ground and walking with it.
7. Become familiar with safety equipment (arm guards, finger tabs, quiver etc.) and how to use it.
8. Learn three archery terms.
